Occupation measure of random walks and wired spanning forests in balls of Cayley graphs

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We often omitted a necessary hypothesis, as pointed out by Tom Hutchcroft. Namely, we should assume throughout Sections 1 and 2 that the random walk is irreducible, which, in the case of a Cayley graph, is the same as assuming that the support of the random walk generates the group.

Also, in the proof of Corollary 2.6, “the preceding two lemmas” should be “Lemmas 2.3 and 2.5”.

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
